- Ministry development – through the various focus groups (sisters, brothers and youth departments etc.)

Mission Strategy

Evangelism – we share the gospel of Jesus Christ

Community – we serve our local community by focusing on those needs within the community that we might positively affect. *Education* (drug awareness in schools, being positive role models in schools, mentoring). *Family awareness* (helping families communicate with each other and helping them to appreciate the value of the family unit) and *social support* (touching the lives of the elderly, ex-offenders, homeless persons and those with drug related problems)

Development – we encourage the spiritual maturity and development of the believer in Christ. Through the practical application of biblical teaching, ministry, worship and fellowship, through the planting of churches, our commitment to mission and the opportunity to serve.

Vision

To effect an increase in the number of people committing their lives to Christ.

To evangelise, support missions and plant churches under the covering of the PCF.

To befriend our neighbours.

To create opportunities where we can service our local community in schools, hospitals, social caring groups, the voluntary sector, in partnership with the local authority and strategic groups and churches. To provide counselling services, to introduce helpful presentations, focusing on the welfare of the peoples in our locality.

To see the manifestation and fruit of the Spirit-filled life in every believer, being baptised taking up membership and in regular Christian fellowship. To support and encourage believers - specifically helping them develop their own gifting and ministry. To promote the importance of a worshipful lifestyle.
