# Making a difference in your community

In 2004, Joseph Steinberg, UK Director of Jews for Jesus, ministered during our morning service on the topic of Christ in the Passover. Thanks to many of your prayer support, there has been a lot of work continuing in the Jewish community. This is what Jews for Jesus wanted to share with PCF:

“We have been so encouraged during the last year as we have settled into our new building in Camden Town. We have now opened an outreach centre there with shop-front, as well as facilities for visits and group teaching on site. Already the shop-front is proving to be an excellent way of engaging with people in the locality. Last summer, we undertook a major evangelistic campaign among the Jewish community in Manchester. During the campaign, over 165,000 gospel tracts were given out and 33 people came to a saving faith in Jesus on the streets including one Jewish person. 585 people also gave their names and addresses for follow up. Of these, 55 people were unbelieving Jews and 209 were unbelieving gentiles. We would ask your prayers as we continue to follow up all these contacts which is the most important part of our ongoing work.”

# Making a difference around the world

Around the world, millions of Christians are persecuted for their faith every year and the number is growing. In **China** for example, you could be arrested and imprisoned for leading an unregistered ‘underground’ house church. Or for just attending your church.



In **Pakistan** you could be harassed or even murdered by Islamic militants, just for being a follower of Jesus Christ. In the repressive regime of **North Korea**, you could be sent to one of the notorious ‘torture’ camps where literally tens of thousands have disappeared.

This is why Release International is urgently calling on Christians in the UK and Ireland to pray for these and other situations around the world. Seven countries have been identified where Christians face intense persecution and your support is asked to commit to pray for these nations for seven years.
