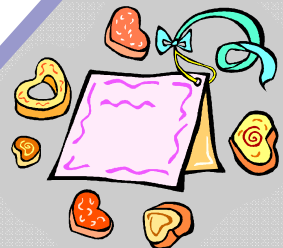


For SIA to continue, it needs **YOUR** help. If you would like to get involved with producing the weekly bulletin, please have a chat with Colleen or Harold.
